



Reservations

Routes and Timings

Your travel documentation will be sent to you five to seven days prior to departure. Please note, routes and timings are subject to the constraints of the rail network and may alter. Please arrive 20 minutes prior to departure.

Dining

Your fare includes set meals as described in the journey. Let us know special dietary requirements when booking. We are unable to prepare meals requiring strict religious observance in their preparation.

Mobile phones

Please switch your phone or hand held device to 'silent' while in your carriage.

Smoking

We operate a no smoking policy on board; this also applies to e-cigarettes.

Insurance

We recommend you purchase adequate travel insurance for your trip. We cannot be held responsible for loss of deposits and/or other costs you might incur if you cancel your reservation. Please see Booking Conditions for details.

Wheelchair Users

We regret that our carriages cannot be boarded in wheelchairs. However, our staff are available to assist passengers to their seats and folding wheelchairs can be stored in the vestibules.

Seating

There are seven passenger carriages, each with the same layout of tables for two and four. Tables for two are allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please note that you may be seated sharing a table.

Gratuities

These are entirely at the discretion of the passenger and are not included in your fare. Tips are usually shared by all members of the on-board crew.

Attire

Smart casual attire (no jeans or trainers) is recommended, a jacket and tie is often required. Please wear practical clothing for outdoor events. For all dinner journeys formal wear is customary.





BOOKING CONDITIONS

Our booking conditions contain important limitations and exclusions of liability. Please read them before we confirm your booking. Please ensure you have adequate travel insurance in place.

1. Booking and Paying For Your Arrangements Subject to availability, a booking will be made with us when (1) you tell us that you would like to accept our written or verbal quotation and (2) you pay us the applicabledeposit being 15% of the cost of your arrangements unless we notify you otherwise in writing (or if booking within 56 days of departure full payment) and (3) we issue aconfirmation invoice. A binding contract will come into existence as soon as we have issued a confirmation invoice confirming the details of your booking (and the due payment dates for any applicable balance to be paid) which will be sent to you or your travel agent. If you believe that any details on it (or any other travel document issued by us) are wrong you must advise us immediately as changes cannot be made later and it may harm your rights if we are not notified of any inaccuracies in any travel document within 10 days of our sending it out. If there are less than 12 passengers in your party and if you have made your booking more than 56 days before departure andhave paid a deposit to secure your booking, the balance of the cost of your arangements (including any applicable surcharge) is due not less than 56 days prior to scheduled departure. If there are 12 or more passengers in your party, payments must be made as follows: 15% of the cost of your arrangements is payable on booking, a further 35% of such cost (including any applicable surcharge) is due 90 days before departure (if your booking is made between 90 and 56 days from departure, you will be required to pay 50% of the cost of your arrangements on booking) and the balance is due 56 days before departure (if your booking is made less than 56 days before departure, you will be required to pay the entire cost of your arrangements at the time of your booking). If we do not receive (in cleared funds) the balance in full and on time, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled by you in which case the cancellation charges set out in clause 2 below will become payable.
